A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE VILLAGE OF MADRID UTILITY RATES.

The Village of Madrid Board of Trustees has been encouraged to address the cost of operation, as well as reflect the increase included with our Waste Connections contract, by our auditors. This will require increasing the water, sewer and trash rates.

A. INCREASES

- 1. Current quarterly water rates will be increased \$1.00 for a total of \$77.00
- 2. Current guarterly sewer rates will be increased \$1.00 for a total of \$35.00
- 3. Current quarterly trash rates will be increased \$2.00 for a total of \$62.00
- 4. Monthly users will incur a \$1.00/month increase, which will reflect the cost of quarterly users, plus \$1.00/month administrative fee.
- 5. The total quarterly increase will be \$4.00 and the total monthly increase will be \$1.00.

B. EFFECTIVE DATE:

The new rates will increase during the first quarter of 2020. Monthly users will see the increase on their March bill. Quarterly users will see the increase in their first quarter bill which is issued the first week of April.

This resolution will be in full effect after passage by the board of trustees and certification by the clerk.

This resolution was passed on the 10th day of February, 2020 at the monthly village board meeting.

The purpose of this resolution to to declare a local health emergency and to provide authority for the Board of Trustees to take actions that said Board deems to be prudent in light of said emergency for the health, safety, and welfare of the Village's citizens and employees.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MADRID, PERKINS COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

- 1. That the Village of Madrid has the obligation to provide services during regular posted business hours, and to provide some services such as trash, water, and sewer; and,
- 2, That the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and employees of the Village is a priority for the Village and its Board of Trustees; and,
- 3. That in the event of public health emergency is declared by the World Health Organization or the Government of the United States or the Center for Disease Control or the Government of the State of Nebraska, or local authorities; and,
- 4. That due to the the current outbreak of COVID-19 (coronavirus) and pursuant to Executive Order No. 20-03 issued by the office the Governor Pete Ricketts:

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF MADRID:

- 1. That a state of emergency exists.
- 2. That pursuant to the Executive Order No. 20-03 certain requirements under the Open Meetings Act are hereby suspended.
- 3. That monthly meetings of the Board of Trustees are hereby closed to the public, and that the Council, may at their discretion, hold said meetings telephonically.

- 4. That all public offices and buildings are hereby closed until further notice.
- 5. That Employees who can work remotely may do so after receiving approval of the Chairman of the Board.
- 6. That the Board may grant requests for additional administrative or sick leave, on an individual basis, if said Board determines it to be in the best interest of the public and the employees.
- 7. That the Board, at its discretion, may take additional remedial actions, based upon orders and recommendations of the organizations set forth in paragraph 2 above, including to, but not limited to, taking additional actions deemed prudent by the Board of Trustees, or declaring the emergency to be over.
- 8. That the Village shall continue to provide expected services to the residents and businesses of the Village as may be made with reasonable and safe efforts.
